

How to prepare an USB for Windows Installation?

Note: Insert Windows CD/DVD and attached 4G.B USB drive then follow following steps:

Step 1:



Click Start Menu Then type **diskpart** on search box



Following Screen will be appear on desktop

Step 2: Type **List Disk**

Step 3: Type **Select Disk 1**

Following Screen will be appear on desktop

Disk 1 is now the selected disk.

Step 4: Type **Clean**

```
DISKPART> clean
DiskPart succeeded in cleaning the disk.
DISKPART>
```

Step 5: Type **Create Partition Primary**

Following Screen will be appear on desktop

```
DISKPART> create partition primary
DiskPart succeeded in creating the specified partition.
DISKPART>
```

Step 6: Type **Format fs=fat32 quick**

Step 7: Type **Active**

Step 8: Type **Exit**

Step 9: Now Open windows CD/DVD from My Computer then select all files which are presents in CD/DVD for copy.

Step 10: Open USB drive then paste all data.
